New Bike Repair Station Downtown

On Monday, April 11th the Port of Cascade Locks and City of Cascade Locks participated in a brief ribbon cutting on a brand new bike repair station in our downtown. The repair station is free for the public to use. It is located at Overlook Park near the Post Office, the future site of the community's Gorge Hub. The new bike repair station includes an upright stand, an air pump to inflate tires, and 6 common repair tools attached to the stand by sturdy retractable cables. The dollars for the repair stations for each of the Oregon communities along the Historic Highway came from a generous donation by the Portland Wheelmen Touring Club. There will ultimately be Gorge Hubs in Wood Village, Troutdale, Cascade Locks, Hood River, Mosier, and The Dalles. The City of Cascade Locks has applied for an Oregon Parks & Rec. Dept. grant to fund the construction of parking lot improvements, restroom, drinking fountain, maps, signage, and landscaping. The Cascade Locks Hub is designed to connect to a bicycle/pedestrian overcrossing into Marine Park.

Port History: 10 Years Ago this Week

One decade ago the Port of Cascade Locks made a difficult and controversial decision to lease the Sternwheeler *Columbia Gorge* river boat to the Portland Spirit (American Waterways Inc). The private company continues to operate river cruises from Cascade Locks between May and October each year.
