

Flex 2 and 4

There certainly has been a lot of activity on Herman Creek Lane. Flex 2 is now fully erected with contractors working to complete the electrical, plumbing and fire suppression system. When weather will allow the parking lot will be graded and sidewalks completed. Next, Port staff will finish the building interior with painting, doors and trim. The building is expected to be ready for tenants to move in by mid-March. Contractors were able to pour the concrete slab of Flex Building 4 the last week of December thanks to our mild winter weather. After a curing period, they were able to complete erection of red iron and the installation of the sheeting. Finally, the roof is currently being installed. The Port intends for Flex Building 4 to be ready for tenants to move in by the end of May.

Toll Increase for 3-8 axle Vehicles

This past November the Port Commission approved an increase in tolls for large trucks, RV's and buses with 3 or more axles. The new toll rates for trucks will be \$3 per axle for all cash and credit card transactions. With the purchase of a 20 coupon book, customers will get a rate of \$2 per axle and a considerable discount. Coupon books can be purchased at the Toll Booth or at the Port Office in the Marine Park. There will be no change in tolls for 2 axle cars and trucks or 2 axle dual rear wheel vehicles. This toll increase will go into effect February 1st, 2018. Important future maintenance projects include painting projects, deck welding, and approach deck overlays.

Airport Town Hall Meeting

The Port Commission has set the date of February 22 at 7pm in the Pavilion for a Town Hall meeting regarding the airport. The Ports consultant on the study will facilitate the meeting. The purpose of the meeting is to allow local citizens and airplane interests an opportunity to offer suggestions, ideas and concerns. The full study is just now getting started, so the opportunity to be heard and express an opinion is very important. The meeting will be held in the Pavilion. Refreshments and hard work will be available for attendees.

Moody Road Property

The Port is going to have volunteers working in and around our Moody Road property cleaning out the first 20 feet back from Moody Road on the Ports property. This is to keep rapid growth from overtaking the road and getting the work done for much less than it would cost the Port if we had to pay for it.

Dredging in the Marina

Every 3-4 years the Marina requires dredging to keep water depth at a safe, accessible level. Over this period of time, silt deposits from the river make their way into the mouth of the marina and eventually lead to issues for the larger keel vessels. This dredging is set to take place on February 21st and will last approximately 7 days.

Pony Task Force

The new Pony Task Force met January 11 for their organizational meeting. Marie Miller was elected Chairperson and JoAnn Wittenberg was elected vice chairperson. The committee reviewed the report and recommendations of the previous committee and then elected to meet the second and fourth Thursday of every month in order to get their work done within the vear.
