PAID PARKING & SECURITY

Please welcome Eric Franzen, Port's Security Officer. Eric is coming to us with lots of relevant experience in law enforcement, as well as parks. The role of the security officer is to enforce Port's ordinances, including paid parking, monitor port's properties, assist visitors, and many more! The Security Officer position with the port is funded through the paid parking program. Paid parking program will see additional payment by cash option in the Marine Park closer to the summer. Other convenient ways to pay are through the Passport Parking App or phone number posted around the parking spaced. District residents can obtain a parking permit free of charge at the Port Office. COVID has had many impacts on our community. One of those is larger numbers of people exercising in the park. By having a system that tracks vehicles on Port properties, we can get better control numbers of visitors to help prevent the spread of the virus. While residents of the Port District will not have to pay for their parked cars, we expect the funds generated by others will offset the cost of the parking features we will be installing around the park. While typically permits are issued by cities or Park & Rec districts, which are supported by district residents' taxes, that is not the case for Marine Park.
