OPEN BUDGET COMMITTEE SEATS

The Port Commission is accepting letters of interest from residents of the port district who are interested in serving their community as a member on the Port's Budget Committee. The Budget Committee of 10 is composed of all five Port Commissioners plus five citizen members. There are currently three open seats to fill 4-year terms, ending December of 2025.

Q: What does a Budget Committee Member do?

A: Volunteer budget committee members are expected to attend a preliminary orientation session, plus a series of three to four meetings between April and May of 2023. The committee reviews and revises the draft budget prepared by Port staff in order to support the adopted mission, vision, and priorities of the Port. Previous years' budgets are available for reference. Questions are encouraged. Experience in business and/or budgeting is desirable and helpful. This is a great opportunity to get involved with the Port.
