POST-SEIZURE NOTICE

This is notification that the vessel, a 20' Wayfarer fiberglass sailboat with the registration number OR766ZL (the "Wayfarer"), was seized by the Port of Cascade Locks (the "Port") on February 5, 2021. If \$204.00 is not paid to the Port before 4:30 on March 7, 2022, title to the vessel and all personal property found on the vessel will vest in the Port.

Pursuant to Oregon Statutes § 830.908 et seq., a vessel that is left without authorization on public lands is deemed to be abandoned. The Wayfarer was left in the Marina at Marine Park without payment since July 9th, 2021. On February 5, 2022 at 8:00a.m., the Port seized the Wayfarer pursuant to the Port's authority under ORS §830.911 to seize abandoned vessels. Upon entering the Wayfarer, the Port discovered the following items of personal property:

- 15 Horse Power Honda Outboard
- 2 Fuel cans
- 5 Plug surge protector
- Pink tool box with assorted tools
- Binoculars
- Boat Sail
- Grey rachet set
- 2 plug cords
- Orange drill
- Assorted straps
- 100ft rope
- Mini Vacuum
- Assorted bungies
- Battery
- Assorted cleaning supplies

The registered owner of the Wayfarer is liable for all salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs incurred by the Port by reason of the seizure. As of February 11, 2022, the amount of salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs incurred by the Port was \$204.00. The costs of salvage, towing, and storage must be paid no later than 4:30 p.m. on March 7, 2022. If the registered owner does not pay \$204.00 to the Port before 4:30 on March 7, 2022, title to the vessel and all personal property found in the vessel will



immediately vest in the Port. The vessel and its contents may be immediately reclaimed by presenting proof of ownership or right to possession and payment of costs that have accrued.

The owner of a vessel seized under ORS §§830.908 to 930.948 may request a hearing to challenge seizure of the vessel and the reasonableness of any salvage, towing or storage costs. The request must be submitted in writing and include a statement of the specific grounds on which the seizure is challenged, and whether the owner challenges the reasonableness of any salvage, towing, or storage costs incurred by the enforcement agency. In order to be considered, your request for a hearing must be **received** in writing by the Port no later than 4:30 on February 21, 2021.
